INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE OF WORK

Introduction

For System Integrator

- 1) **Supply:** Entrusted bidder must supply and work as per work order. All supplies must be certified, new and RoHS compliant. Supplied components must satisfy the minimum guiding specifications and guidelines, as applicable, proprietary technology must be mentioned against each component. Bidder is allowed to propose only one make / model per system or software required for the proposed solution. Bids with optional offers would be summarily rejected.
- 2) **Installation, Integration & Implementation:** Delivery & Installation will be governed by the stated guidelines and associated standards & in line with the scope of work defined in this document. The delivery / supply of the materials done by successful Bidder at respective location only. The Post installation warranty supports are the sole responsibility of the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM).
- 3) **Service Quality and Assurance:** Services within installation, warranty period must be rendered with OEM for hardware.
- 4) **Acceptance:** After successful Delivery & installation, installation reports prepare by WTL, signed and sealed by the appropriate authority.
- 5) **Warranty:** The System Integrator has to provide on-site warranty of 01(One) year on the Lab Equipment. The Consumables covers Warranty of 03 Months only. The System Integrator has to provide technical support to the trained school teachers during the warranty period of 01 year over the Phone and Email
- 6) **Delivery:** All materials are initially to be delivered at the locations mentioned in the enclosed Consignee list. After necessary checking, testing, marking of the all materials under supervision of WTL, successful bidder will take necessary step to transport the material at installation site and take up the installation there at their own cost. Any sticker/ stationery item required to complete the marking will be provided by successful bidder.
- 7) **Warranty Certificate:** On successful installation bidder to get installed equipment with actual serial no. duly certified by respective OEM for Three years warranty coverage. Any change in equipment serial no. should be reflected in OEM website or OEM declaration in their Letter head. Final Bills will be submitted after completion of this activity.
- 8) **Service Level Agreement (SLA):** The SLA will be signed between WTL and selected bidder after issuing the final work order.

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- 9) Consortium is allowed in this tender with one Consortium Member. Notarized Copy of Tender specific Consortium Agreement to be submitted.

2. The Rates of the items given in the Price Bid should be valid for the period of 02(Two) years.
3. The number of schools can be increased or decreased as per the direction received from the Department of School Education, Govt, of West Bengal

Training of Teachers

The System Integrator has to provide Training to the Physics & Computer Teachers of all the listed schools in multiple Zones consisting of various schools as per list given below:

Note: The above mentioned training locations are tentative only, final training location will be finalized after discussion with WBBSE subject to maximum 05 Training Locations.

The training duration will be 2 Days which will include the process of training to be imparted to the students along with the basic practical demonstration of few equipment and consumables.

The System Integrator has to provide a training kit to all the participant teachers along with the training completion certificate.

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SECTION – B **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. The Bidder must be a company registered under Companies Act, or Partnership or LLP. Certificate of incorporation/Partnership Deed to be submitted.
2. The Bidder/Prime Bidder and consortium partner must be a System Integrator in IT/ ITeS/ ICT sector. Relevant document to be submitted.
3. The Bidder/Prime Bidder and consortium partner should have been operating for the last 10 years in Kolkata. Certificate of Incorporation and/ or Certificate of Commencement of Business issued by the Registrar of Companies/ Partnership Registration Certificate to be submitted.
4. The Bidder/Prime Bidder and consortium partner should have valid GST Registration Certificate, PAN, P.Tax & EPF Registration. Bidder shall have to submit valid documents issued before publication of this tender.
5. The Bidder/Prime Bidder and consortium partner should have own local call center number (Undertaking letter should be submitted from the bidders). OEM Call Centre number will not be treated as bidder's call center number. Call Center details for bidder with number & details of call center infrastructure and manpower must be submitted. Bidder shall have to submit the Complain/Call escalation matrix in their own letterhead with undertaking.
6. The Bidder/Prime Bidder shall have executed atleast One Project of "IT & ITeS" in single order an amount not less than Rs. 02.00 Crores in last 05 (Five) financial years (considering FY – 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 to 2023-24) in Government Department /PSU/Autonomous Body. Work Order Copy and Completion Certificate of the project to be submitted.

OR

The Bidder/Prime Bidder shall have executed atleast Two "IT & ITeS" orders not less than Rs. 1.50 Crores each in last 05 (Five) financial years (considering FY – 2019-20 to 2023-24) in Government Department/PSU/Autonomous Body. Work Order Copy and Completion Certificate of the project to be submitted.

OR

The Bidder/Prime Bidder shall have executed atleast Three "IT & ITeS" orders not less than Rs.1.00 (One) Crore each in last 05 (Five) financial years (considering FY – 2019-20 to 2023-24) in Government Department/PSU/Autonomous Body. Work Order Copy and Completion Certificate of the project to be submitted.

7. The Bidder/Prime Bidder must have completed Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of any IT/ITeS/ICT Project, worth all-inclusive cumulative amount of Rs. 5.00 (Five crore) only, during last five financial years (considering FY – 2019-20 to 2023-24) for any Govt. Departments or Public Sector Undertakings in India. Work Order Copy and Completion Certificate of the project to be submitted
8. The Bidder or Prime Bidder & Consortium Partner (together) should have an average annual turnover of not less than Rs. 50.00 (Fifty) Crores in the last three financial years (considering FY –

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2021-22, 2022-2023 to 2023-24). Bidder shall have to submit Audited Balance Sheet / Auditor Certificate with UDIN in support of their claim.

9. The Bidder/Prime Bidder should have Positive net worth for last 03 (Three) financial years (considering FY – 2021-22, 2022-2023 to 2023-24). CA Certificate with UDIN has to be submitted along with the Technical Bid.
10. The Bidder/Prime Bidder shall have Quality Certificate (ISO 9001:2015, 14001:2015, 27001:2022, 20000-1:2018). The bidder shall submit the valid certificates issued before publication of the tender.
11. The Bidder/Prime Bidder should have OEM Certified AI & Robotics Trainer on their Payroll. OEM Certificate and CV of the trainer should be submitted
12. The Bidder/Prime Bidder must submit the tender specific Manufacturers Authentication Form (MAF) for Electronics Development Kit, IoT Kit & Robotics Kit as per prescribed format enclosed (Section - Q), along with Technical Compliance statements. Without these documents from the OEMs, the offer will be treated as non-responsive and summarily rejected.
13. The Bidder/Prime Bidder shall not have been blacklisted by any State/Central Government or PSU Organization or bilateral / multilateral funding agencies for breach of ethical conduct or fraudulent practices as on date of submission of the proposal (as per DIT guidance note issued on 26-Dec-2011). Declaration on bidder's letter head to be submitted.
14. The bidder shall submit Bid Form (Section – E) duly signed by the authorized signatory of the company as per the format enclosed. Deviation in format may not be accepted.
15. Bidder shall submit NIT Declaration (Section - O) duly signed by the authorized signatory of the company as per the format. Deviation in format may not be accepted.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA FOR OEM:

The OEM of the Innovation Lab Kits as a product consisting of various equipment and consumable should have following eligibility criteria, any OEM not conforming to any of these parameters will be rejected.

1. The OEM must be a company registered under Companies Act, 1956/2013 or Partnership or LLP. Certificate of incorporation/Partnership Deed to be submitted.
2. The OEM should have been operating for the last 05 years in Kolkata. Certificate of Incorporation and/ or Certificate of Commencement of Business issued by the Registrar of Companies/ Partnership Registration Certificate to be submitted.
3. The OEM should have their registered office in Kolkata. Valid trade license and local GST Registration Certificate are to be submitted.
4. The OEM should have atleast 03 Years of Experience in Supply, & Installation of Innovation/Robotics/AI Labs in India. Relevant work order copy to be submitted.
5. The OEM should have completed the work of Supply, & Installation of Innovation/Robotics/AI Labs worth atleast 03 Crore in total covering atleast 250 Schools in India in last 03 Financial Year (2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24).
6. The OEM should have Total Turnover of atleast 20 Crore in last 03 Financial Year (2021-22, 2022-23, 2023-24).

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SECTION – D

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDER

1. DEFINITIONS

In this document, the following terms shall have following respective meanings:

“**Agreement**” means the Agreement to be signed between the successful bidder and WTL including all attachments, appendices, all documents incorporated by reference thereto together with any subsequent modifications, the RFP, the bid offer, the acceptance and all related correspondences, clarifications, presentations.

“**Acceptance Test Document**” means a document, which defines procedures for testing the functioning of installed system. The document will be finalized with the contractor within 7 days of issuance of the Letter of Award.

“**Bidder**” means any firm offering the solution(s), service(s) and /or materials required in the RFP. The word Bidder when used in the pre award period shall be synonymous with Bidder, and when used after award of the Contract shall mean the successful Bidder.

“**Contract**” is used synonymously with Agreement.

“**Contract Price**” means the price to be paid to the Contractor for providing the Solution, in accordance with the payment terms.

“**Contractor**” means the Bidder whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by Tender Committee and is named as such in the Letter of Award.

“**Default Notice**” mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.

“**Installation**” means installation of supplied Hardware & Software.

“**Fraudulent Practice**” means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a Contract and includes collusive practice among Bidders (prior to or after Bid submission) designed to establish Bid prices at artificial noncompetitive levels and to deprive WTL and eventually Departments of Gov. of W. Bengal of the benefits of free and open competition.

“**GoI**” shall stand for the Government of India.

“**GoWB**” means Government of West Bengal.

“**Personnel**” means persons hired by the Bidder as employees and assigned to the performance of the Infrastructure Solution or any part thereof.

“**Similar Nature of Work**” means Integrated Learning and Assessment Solution under Education Department, GoWB..

“**Project**” means Integrated Learning and Assessment Solution under Education Department, GoWB.

“**Services**” means the work to be performed by the Bidder pursuant to this Contract, as described in the detailed Scope of Work.

“**Interest rate**” means “364 days Government of India (GoI) Treasury Bills” rate.

“**Law**” shall mean any Act, notification, bye law, rules and regulations, directive, ordinance, order or instruction having the force of law enacted or issued by the Central Government and/or the

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Government of West Bengal or any other Government or regulatory authority or political subdivision of government agency.

“**LOI**” means issuing of Letter of Intent shall constitute the intention of the WTL to place the Purchase Order with the successful bidder.

“**Requirements**” shall mean and include schedules, details, description, statement of technical data, performance characteristics, standards (Indian as well as International) as applicable and specified in the Contract.

“**Service**” means provision of Contracted service viz., operation, maintenance and associated services for DEPLOYED SYSTEMS along with centralized dashboard as per Section titled “Scope of Work”.

“**Termination Notice**” means the written notice of termination of the Agreement issued by WTL.

“**ED**” means Education Department.

“**WTL**” means Webel Technology Limited a Govt. of West Bengal undertaking.

2. **PRE BID MEETING**

Pre Bid Meeting will be held on 28.02.2025 at 11.00 hrs. (On-Line Meeting). Bidder can send their queries as per format (Section - L) to Purchase Department (purchase@wtl.co.in). Only the queries received within the stipulated date prior to the Pre Bid Meeting will be answered. Interest bidders are requested to send mail to (purchase@wtl.co.in) for participation of online pre-bid meeting. Based on request WTL will share meeting id / links for meeting. If there is any change in date and time then will inform.

3. **COST OF BIDDING**

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid and WTL will no case be responsible for those costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. **BID DOCUMENT**

Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and requirement in the bid document. The invitation to bid together with all its attachment thereto shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidder unless deviations are specifically stated in the seriatim by the bidder. Failure to furnish all information required by the bid document or a bid not substantially responsive to the bid document in every respect may result of the bid.

5. **AMENDMENT OF BID DOCUMENT**

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, WTL reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issuance of a Corrigendum, which would be published on the website and will also be made available to the all the Bidder who have been issued the tender document. The Corrigendum shall be binding on all bidders and will form part of the bid documents.

6. **MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS**

The bidder cannot modify or withdraw its bid after submission.

7. **LANGUAGE OF BID & CORRESPONDENCE**

The proposal will be prepared by the Bidder in English language only. All the documents relating to the proposal (including brochures) supplied by the firm should also be in English, and the correspondence between the Bidder & WTL will be in English language only. The correspondence by fax/E-mail must be subsequently confirmed by a duly signed formal copy.

8. **BIDDER'S SOLUTION**

The bidders are requested to study the Bill of Material supplied with this document carefully. While working out the solution the bidder has to work with the broad minimum specification provided in the

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tender documents, conforming to the model, make and Part number (wherever provided). While submitting the bid the bidder has to detail out all components needed to complete the system BOM. The bidder is required quote for each item retaining all major components/sub system detailed and specified. As the contractor will be responsible for smooth functioning of the system, availability of spares during the tenure of the warranty period have to be take care by the contractor to maintain the guaranteed uptime.

9. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)& TENDER FEE

The bidder shall furnish Online Receipt against payment of Tender Fees and Earnest Money Deposit.

10. REFUND OF EMD

EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders without interest by following guidelines of circular 3975-F(Y) dated 28/07/2016 on final selection of Successful Bidders.

11. FORFEITURE OF EMD

EMD made by Bidder may be forfeited under the following conditions:

If Bidder withdraws the proposal before the expiry of validity period.

During the evaluation process, if a Bidder indulges in any such activity as would jeopardize the process, the decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon question under any circumstances.

If Bidder violates any of the provisions of the terms and conditions of the proposal.

In the case of a successful Bidder, if Bidder fails to:

- a) Accept the work order along with the terms and conditions.
- b) Furnish performance security.
- c) Violates any of the work conditions of this proposal or indulges in any such activities as would jeopardize the work.
- d) Submitting false/misleading information/declaration/documents/proof/etc.

The decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon to question under any circumstances, besides, forfeiture of EMD even the Bidder will be deferred from participating in any job for a period of one year.

12. FORMS AND FORMATS

The various inputs for the Techno Commercial as Financial Bids are to be submitted in the format specified. The bidder shall use the form, wherever specified, to provide relevant information. If form does not provide space for any required information, space at the end of the form or additional sheets shall be used to convey the said information. For all other cases, the bidder shall design a form to hold the required information.

13. LACK OF INFORMATION TO BIDDER

The bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined the Bid document to his entire satisfaction. Any lack of information shall not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to fulfill his obligation under the bid. If bidder has any queries relating to bid document, then he can send the queries before the Pre Bid Meeting.

14. CONTRACT EXECUTION

On receipt of the Letter of Award the contractor should submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 10% of the total contract value within three weeks from the date of receipt of Letter of Award/Order. The PBG should be valid for six month more than the warranty period. All delivery of the material will have to be completed within 30 days from the date of acceptance of contract and the contractor has to ensure all activities leading to the commissioning of the contract to be completed within 90 days from the date of award. Subsequent to the award of contract, the contractor will have to arrange for the requisite material as per BOM.

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15. TIME SCHEDULE FOR DELIVERY & INSTALLATION

Materials will be delivered at identified schools district wise. One set of material will be delivered at each classroom in each School. Delivery should be made within 6 to 8 weeks after receiving of Work Order at all locations in West Bengal. Installation within 3 weeks after delivery for both West Bengal State.

16. LIQUIDATED DAMAGE

The job includes the supply and installation of materials mentioned in the tender document. In the event of failure to meet the job completion in stipulated date/time liquidated damage may be imposed on the contractor for sum not less than 0.5% of the contract value for undelivered/installed items, each week or part thereof, subject to a ceiling of 3% of the total contract value (including all taxes & duties and other charges). In the event of LD exceeds 3% of the order value, WTL reserves the right to terminate the contract and WTL will get the job completed by any other competent party. The difference of cost incurred by WTL will be recovered from the contractor and PBG will be invoked.

17. LIABILITY

In case of a default on bidder's part or other liability, WTL shall be entitled to recover damages from the Contractor. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which WTL is entitled to claim damages from the Contractor (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), Contractor shall be liable for no more than:

- Payment referred to in the Patents and Copyrights clause.
- Liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property limited to that cause by the Contractor's negligence.
- As to any other actual damage arising in any situation involving nonperformance by Contractor pursuant to or in any way related to the subject of this Agreement, the charge paid by WTL for the individual product or Service that is the subject of the Claim. However, the contractor shall not be liable for
- For any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data.

For any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the Contractor hereunder.

18. PATENTS & COPYRIGHT

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the Contractor to WTL infringes that party's patent or copyright, the Contractor shall defend WTL against that claim at Contractor's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the Contractor, provided that WTL.

- Promptly notifies Contractor in writing of the claim
- Allows Contractor to control and co-operate with Contractor in the defense and any related settlement negotiations.

Remedies: If such a claim is made or appears likely to be made, WTL would permit Contractor to enable WTL to continue to use the product, or to modify it, or replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent. If Contractor determines that none of these alternatives is reasonably available, WTL agrees to return the product to Contractor on Contractor's written request. Contractor will then give WTL a credit equal to for a machine. WTL's net book value (provided WTL has followed generally accepted accounting principles for a generally available software product produced by Contractor (Program) the amount paid by WTL or 12 months charges (whichever is lesser) and for materials the amount paid by WTL for the materials. These will be Contractor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement.

19. SUSPENSION OF WORK

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

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TERMS OF PAYMENT

90% Payment against delivery of materials on submission of duly stamped and signed Deliver Challan by the School Principal/Head Teacher along with the Invoice in triplicate copies.

10% Payment against successful completion of Training of Teachers on submission of Training Completion Report duly signed by the teachers who attended the training.

Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer.

20. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

21. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT PRACTICES

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose, the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

22. BINDING CLAUSE

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned. The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

23. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the workmen's compensation Act 1923 or any other relevant acts and rules, compensation to a workman employed by the contractor, is payable, then this should be done by the Contractor. If WTL is obliged to make any compensation under the said rules and acts, then the amount shall be recovered without prejudice, from the bills and due of the Contractor. WTL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against the Contractor in respect of workmen's compensation.

24. CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall comply with the provision of all labour legislation including the requirement of the payment of Wage Act 1936 and the rules framed there under and modifications thereof in respect of men employed by him in carrying out the contract. The Contractor must ensure that he complies with PF, ESI regulation for all his deployed employees. The Contractor shall see that all authorized Sub Contractors under him similarly complied with the above requirement.

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25. SAFETY MEASURES

The Contractor shall in the course of execution of the work take all necessary precaution for the protection of all persons and property. The Contractor shall take adequate measures to protect the work and prevent accident during the work. In the event of any accident to any person or persons or damage or injury of any description to any person or property due to failure on the part of the contractor in taking proper precautionary measures the contractor shall be responsible for and must make good the loss the damage at his own cost to the satisfaction of the department and employees of the department shall be indemnified from all claims or liabilities arising there from or any expenses incurred on account thereof.

26. EQUIPMENT

All tools & tackles necessary for the work shall have to be procured by the contractor unless otherwise specified elsewhere in these tender documents. The equipment used by the contractor for a particular work must be appropriate for the type of work. The contractor shall maintain the equipment used on the work properly so that they are in good working condition. In no case shall the contractor use defective or imperfect equipment in the work. The contractor shall arrange to replace or repair all defective equipment so that the progress of the work is not hampered. No defective equipment should be left at the site of work and the department shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any of these equipment during the course of the execution of the work.

27. SUB-CONTRACT

The purchaser (WTL) does not recognize the existence of Sub-Contractors. The Contractor's responsibility is not transferable. No consortium partner is allowed.

28. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

29. BANKRUPTCY

If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

30. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.

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- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public **transportation** and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.
- Give rise to any claim fro damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

31. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Appropriate insurance to cover all solution components for the transit period and until the time of its acceptance at the respective site is to be taken by the contractor. As the contractor will carry the risk for the material in his books during transit, the contractor should arrange insurance for the total system as period from the dispatch till Acceptance Test is successfully achieved. Further the contractor is to take all required insurance coverage in respect of all its personnel who shall be working on this engagement.

32. WARRANTY

The bidder will provide 12 months warranty support on the equipment(s) for and 03 months on consumable from the date delivery.

33. WARRANTY SUPPORT

The total system will be warranted against all defects/bugs from the date of acceptance of the system whole or part.

34. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment as well as performance of on-site warranty support, as mentioned in Bill of Material, from the date of final acceptance of systems and pertaining to proper running of the systems, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the contract value for the period of 12 months as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – N).

35. SI/BIDDER/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

36. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

37. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in

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respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

38. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 12 months. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates. The successful Bidder should agree to implement the project in additional number of classrooms as per requirement of the Department at the same rate offered by them in future.

39. TAXES & DUTIES

42. LATE BID

43. OPENING OF BID BY WTL

Bids shall be opened and downloaded electronically through operation of the process in the e-Tender portal in presence of Tender Committee. Bidders interested to remain present during electronic bid opening may attend the bid opening session at WTL premises at scheduled date & time.

44. CONTACTING WTL

Bidder shall not approach WTL officers beyond office hours and/or outside WTL office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WTL office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WTL, it should be in writing.

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45. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

46. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing taxes, levies, duties, cess etc.

47. PRICE

- Price should be quoted in the BOQ format only. No deviation is acceptable.
- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

48. CANVASSING

Canvassing or support in any form for the acceptance of any tender is strictly prohibited. Any bidder doing so will render him liable to penalties, which may include removal of this name from the register of approved Contractors.

49. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF TENDER

This tender document is not transferable.

50. FORMATS AND SIGNING OF BID

The original and all copies of the proposals shall be neatly typed and shall be signed by an authorized signatory(ies) on behalf of the Bidder. The authorization shall be provided by written Power of Attorney accompanying the proposal. All pages of the proposal, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal. The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erase or overwriting. In order to correct errors made by the Bidder, all corrections shall be done & initialed with date by the authorized signatory after striking out the original words/figures completely.

51. WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Bid cannot be withdrawn during the interval between their submission and expiry of Bid's validity period. Fresh Bid may be called from eligible bidders for any additional item(s) of work not mentioned herein, if so required.

52. INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS

If any bidder should find discrepancies or omission in the specifications or other tender documents, or if he should be in doubt as to the true meaning of any part thereof, he shall make a written request to the tender inviting authority for correction/clarification or interpretation or can put in a separate sheet along with his technical bid document.

53. SPLITTING OF THE CONTRACT AND CURTAILMENT OF WORK

WTL reserves the right to split up and distribute the work among the successful technically qualified bidders and to curtail any item of work in the schedule partly or fully based on scheme requirement. As it is a time constrained process, the work may be distributed as mentioned above at L1 rate arrived through the process.

54. PREPARATION OF TENDER

Tender shall be submitted in accordance with the following instructions:

CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT FORMAT

This Consortium Agreement ("Agreement") is executed on this ___ day of _____, 2022 by and between _____, ("Lead Member"), a Company incorporated under the laws of [SEP] having its Registered Office at _____ (hereinafter called the "Lead Member", which expression shall include its successors, executors and permitted assigns) of the First Part;

And _____, a Company incorporated under the laws of [SEP] having its Office Registered at _____ (hereinafter called the "Consortium Partner", which expression shall include its successors, executors and permitted assigns) of the Second Part.

(Each Member individually shall be referred to as the "Member" or "Party" and both the Members shall be collectively referred to as the "Members" or "Parties" in this Agreement).

WHEREAS, WTL has issued Tender No WTL/ED/IK/24-25/035 dated 21.02.2025 (hereinafter "The Tender") for Request for Proposal (RFP) Document for Delivery, Installation & Training of all the Innovation Kit under Education Department, GoWB and invited bids for this purpose.

AND WHEREAS, the Tender stipulates that the Lead Member may enter into a Consortium Agreement with another Company/ Corporate entity to fulfil the Technical Eligibility Criteria stipulated in Tender NOW THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSTH AS UNDER

In consideration of the above premises and agreements all the Members in this Consortium agreement do hereby mutually agree as follows: ·

1. We, the Members of the Consortium and Members to the Agreement do hereby unequivocally agree that _____ shall act as the Lead Member for the Consortium.
2. The Lead Member shall be liable and responsible for ensuring the individual and collective commitment of each of the Members of the Consortium in discharging all of their respective obligations. Each Member further undertakes to be individually liable for the performance of its part of the obligations envisaged in this Agreement.
3. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the Consortium Partner shall be responsible for providing technical knowledge required for the Tender to the Lead Member. Furthermore, Lead member and Consortium Partner shall enter into a separate definitive agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Definitive Agreement") with each other defining respective rights, duties, obligations, liabilities, etc. of both the parties for the performance of the obligations as per the Tender.
4. This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the Laws of India and courts at Kolkata alone shall have the exclusive jurisdiction in all matters relating thereto and arising there under.
5. It is hereby further agreed that in case of being shortlisted, the Members do hereby agree that they shall abide by the terms & conditions of the Tender.
6. It is further expressly agreed that this Agreement shall be irrevocable and shall form an integral part of the bid submitted to WTL and shall remain in full force and effect until the date of occurrence of any of the following events or conditions. whichever shall first occur: -
 - a) Termination of the Tender;
 - b) Rejection of Bid submitted by the Parties in consortium with each other;
 - c) Contract/Bid is awarded to a third party;
 - d) The Lead Member decides not to submit the Bid.

6. 1 Consequences of Termination/ expiry

(a) Each Party shall handover all information, documents, materials, Confidential Information of the other Party as may be provided by such other Party in accordance with the terms of this Consortium Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days of termination of this Consortium Agreement.

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(b) The Consortium Partner shall maintain all data, all necessary and required records, registers and accounts in respect of the services provided and shall furnish the same to Lead Partner on request.

7. In case the Consortium is declared as successful bidder and Contract is awarded to the Consortium, then Lead Member and Consortium Partner shall enter into Definitive Agreement defining respective rights, duties, obligations, liabilities etc. of both the parties for the performance of the obligations as per Tender. Further, the Consortium Members shall continue to be members of the Consortium and continue to fulfil their respective obligations/scope of work under this Consortium Agreement post award of the Bid/Contract, for the duration specified in the Tender.

8. It is hereby expressly understood between the Members that no Member at any given point of time, may assign or delegate its rights, duties or obligations under this agreement without the explicit permission of WTL.

9. Each Party to this Consortium Agreement shall bear its respective costs, expenses and liabilities as a result of its obligations and efforts under this Agreement. Neither Party shall have any right to any reimbursement, payment or compensation of any kind from each other during the period prior to the award of the contract by WTL nor, any other contract executed in consequence of this Consortium Agreement. However, it is clarified that this clause shall not apply over the Definitive Agreement entered into between both the parties as per this agreement.

10. This Agreement: a) has been duly executed and delivered on behalf of each Member hereto and constitutes the legal, valid, binding and enforceable obligation of each such Member; b) sets forth the entire understanding of the Members hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof: and c) May not be amended or modified except in writing signed by each of the Members and with prior written consent of WTL.

11. If at any time any dispute, differences or question arises between the Parties concerning the meaning, construction, interpretation, effect and scope of this Consortium Agreement regarding the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties under this Consortium Agreement, then such disputes, differences or question shall be amicably resolved through mutual discussions and negotiations ; if the Parties fail to resolve such dispute within 30 days of commencement of amicable settlement process such dispute shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended from time to time). The Arbitration procedure shall be conducted in English language at Kolkata. The arbitration award passed by the sole arbitrator (mutually appointed by the parties) shall be final and binding on the Parties.

12 Legal Relationships

12.1 Relationship between the Parties is on principal to principal basis. This Consortium Agreement does not in any respect make Consortium Partner an agent or a partner of the Lead Member nor does it establish any joint venture between the Parties or authorize the Consortium Partner to transact any business in the name of the Lead Member or to incur any obligation or liability for or on behalf of the Lead Member except as otherwise specifically set forth herein or as may be agreed upon specifically in writing.

12.2 Each Party confirms it is acting on its own behalf and not for the benefit of any other Party.

13. Indemnity

Each Party (the Indemnifying Party") shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other Party (the Indemnified Party") from any and all direct costs, losses, liabilities or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred by the Indemnified Party to the extent arising from the breach by the Indemnifying Party of any of its obligations under this Consortium Agreement.

Each Party acknowledges that monetary damages would not be a sufficient remedy for any breach of this Consortium Agreement by such Party and that the other Party would suffer irreparable harm as a result of any such breach. Accordingly, each Party will be entitled to equitable remedies, including but not limited to injunctive relief and specific performance for any breach or threatened breach of this Consortium Agreement by the other Party, in addition to any other rights or remedies available to such Party.

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14. Limitation of Liability

No Party shall be liable towards the other Party for consequential, indirect, incidental, or special (including multiple or punitive) damages of any kind, including, but not limited to, lost orders, sales or profits.

15. Assignment

Neither party shall have the right to assign or otherwise transfer, in whole or in part, any of its rights or obligations under this Consortium Agreement without obtaining prior written consent from the other party.

16. Severable Terms

The provisions of this Consortium Agreement are severable. If any provision is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in valid, void or unenforceable under the existing law, that provision shall be modified to the extent necessary to make it enforceable. The remaining provisions of this Consortium Agreement or validity of this Consortium Agreement shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

17. Waiver and Amendment

No provision of this Consortium Agreement shall be modified or waived, except by a writing signed by an authorized person from each party in presence of two witnesses .Any failure or delay in asserting any provision or breach does not waive that or any other provision or breach. A waiver does not act as a waiver of any provision or breach on any other occasion.

Entire Agreement

This Consortium Agreement sets forth the entire understanding and agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all other oral or written representations, arrangements and understanding.
