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SECTION – A

SCOPE OF WORK & RESPONSIBILITY

PROJECT BACKGROUND

The ICDS Scheme under the Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal, has undertaken several digital initiatives to strengthen the monitoring, reporting, and service delivery mechanisms. One of the key enablers of this digital transformation is the Poshan Tracker application, which is deployed on smartphones issued to Anganwadi Workers (AWWs) across the state.

To ensure these devices are used securely, efficiently, and in compliance with departmental and national data protection guidelines, there is an immediate need to implement a Mobile Device Management (MDM) solution. The MDM platform will provide centralized control over all field-deployed devices, ensuring data security, policy compliance, and real-time monitoring of device usage. The objective is to safeguard departmental data, enhance operational efficiency, and reduce downtime caused by device misuse, loss, or configuration issues.

The proposed MDM solution will cover approximately 1.05 lakh smartphones used by Anganwadi Workers across West Bengal for a tenure of 4 (four) years.

SCOPE OF WORK & RESPONSIBILITY

Proposed Solution

Bidder's offering must comply with the product specifications and platform capabilities mentioned below. The platform should enable the Department to:

- Track and manage all devices centrally through a secured cloud-based dashboard.
- Enforce security and compliance policies.
- Control application installation and updates.
- Remotely lock or wipe data in case of device theft or loss.
- Generate analytics and MIS reports for audit and governance purposes.

The implementation is planned in a phased manner, starting with solution setup and configuration, followed by rollout support, technical assistance, and continuous monitoring years. The proposal also includes technical support and administrative oversight to ensure smooth operations for four years.

MDM Enrolment

MDM enrolment should happen automatically in Smart Phone through Google Zero touch or OEM Zero touch equivalent platform. MDM license should be provided for 48 months including hosting and technical support.

Product Specification

- Manage device security, push device policies, push custom apps,
- White list or blacklist applications, control device functionality as camera, Bluetooth, WIFI
- MDM should be listed in the Google EMM directory. The quoted MDM solution should be listed as AER (Android Enterprises Recommended) as per Google platform.

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- Enabled for remote troubleshooting solutions - MDM software should have the capability to access the smart phone screen remotely for resolution of software issues whenever required.
- User specific application restrictions and remote actions like device lock or remote wipe
- Features such as Device access password, inactivity timeout and storage encryption
- Install or upgrade applications remotely
- Admin portal to manage smartphones remotely to enroll and unenroll deploy and configure all mobile device applications and security policies
- Real-Time GPS Tracking with Geo-fence & route alerts
- Ability to send push notifications to users selectively and in bulk
- Feature for lost device tracking and take corrective action when a lost device is reported
- Chat between authorized personnel through IMEI numbers. No outsiders should be allowed to join the chat. Chat facility to transfer data , calls, files, and audio/video material in all phones. Chat is to be end to end encrypted with encryption to be At rest and intransit.
- MIS reports and dashboards with role based access control for State Level, District Level and Project Level users

In addition to the above features, bidder must ensure following capabilities are available in proposed MDM platform.

1. Offline Device activities i.e. when devices are not connected to internet, the device still should operate with all configurations and policies that were pushed before.

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Technology Details

The proposed Mobile Device Management (MDM) solution will be a centrally managed, cloud-hosted platform designed to provide comprehensive lifecycle management, policy enforcement, and real-time visibility of all smartphones deployed to Anganwadi Workers (AWWs). The platform will adhere to Government of India's security, data protection, and compliance standards and shall be scalable to support future expansion.

1. System Architecture

- **Cloud hosted MDM Server:**

The core MDM infrastructure will be deployed on a secure cloud environment compliant with MeitY and CERT-In guidelines.

 - Supports multi-tenant, role-based access.
 - Ensures data residency within India in compliance with the DPDP Act and Government of India security policies.
- **Device Agent Application:**

Each smartphone will have an MDM client application installed automatically for policy enforcement, communication with the MDM server, and remote management.

 - Lightweight, always-on background service.
 - Communicates over encrypted HTTPS/TLS 1.2+ channels.
 - Minimal battery and bandwidth consumption.

2. Deliverables (Core Functional Modules)

1. **Device Enrollment & Authentication**
 - Enrollment through IMEI, device serial number, and user credentials.
 - Support for bulk provisioning, QR code-based setup, and factory reset enrollment.
 - Bulk enrolment with device inventory of IMEI numbers.
2. **Policy Management**
 - Security, password, and encryption policies centrally enforced.
 - App-level permissions and restrictions (white/blacklisting).
 - Network control (Wi-Fi, hotspot, data usage policy).
 - Geo-fencing capabilities to restrict usage within assigned areas.
3. **Application & Content Management**
 - Centralized app distribution, update, and removal.
 - Control over installation of unauthorized apps.
 - Remote push of new versions of the **Poshan Tracker** or other approved applications.
4. **Remote Device Management**
 - Real-time GPS tracking and monitoring.
 - Remote lock/wipe functionality for lost or stolen devices.
 - Remote configuration updates, OS upgrades, and security patch deployment.
5. **Monitoring, Analytics & Reporting**
 - Web-based dashboard for administrators.
 - Device health, compliance status, and activity summary.
 - Custom MIS and audit reports exportable in Excel/PDF formats.
 - Automated alerts/ scheduled notifications for non-compliant or inactive devices.

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Key Considerations

Considering that the software solution requires implementation, configuration, integration, and ongoing technical support, participation has been restricted to authorized System Integrator (SI) partners or resellers who are duly authorized by the respective OEM / Product Company to undertake such work. The bidder should be an authorized reseller or System Integrator (SI) partner of leading MDM product complying with “Product Specifications” and “Technology Details” under Section – A, Scope of Work. Following conditions shall apply:

- **Authorized Reseller / System Integrator (SI) Participation:**
Participation in this tender is restricted to authorized resellers or System Integrator (SI) partners of the respective OEM / Product Company. The OEMs themselves shall not be eligible to participate directly in this tender.
- **Authorization Requirement:**
The participating reseller or SI partner must submit a valid authorization letter, reseller certificate, or partnership agreement issued by the original product company (as per Section – Q), clearly indicating their authorization to represent, quote, supply, and provide support for the said product in this tender.
- **Validity:**
The authorization or partnership agreement must be valid as on the date of bid submission and should remain valid for the duration of the project implementation and warranty/support period.
- **OEM Support Commitment:**

“Contract Price” means the price to be paid to the Contractor for providing the Solution, in accordance with the payment terms.

“Contractor” means the Bidder whose bid to perform the Contract has been accepted by Tender Committee and is named as such in the Letter of Award.

“Default Notice” shall mean the written notice of Default of the Agreement issued by one Party to the other.

“Installation” shall means installation of Software.

“Good Industry Practice” shall mean the exercise of that degree of skill, diligence and prudence which would reasonably and ordinarily be expected from a reasonably skilled and experienced Operator engaged in the same type of undertaking under the same or similar circumstances.

“Government” / “Gov. of W. Bengal” means the Government of West Bengal.

“GoI” shall stand for the Government of India.

The bidder shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of the bid and WTL will no case be responsible for those costs regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4. BID DOCUMENT

Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and requirement in the bid document. The invitation to bid together with all its attachment thereto shall be considered to be read, understood and accepted by the bidder unless deviations are specifically stated in the seriatim by the bidder. Failure to furnish all information required by the bid document or a bid not substantially responsive to the bid document in every respect may result of the bid.

5. AMENDMENT OF BID DOCUMENT

At any time prior to the deadline for submission of proposals, WTL reserves the right to add/modify/delete any portion of this document by issuance of an Corrigendum, which would be published on the website and will also be made available to the all the Bidder who have been issued the tender document. The Corrigendum shall be binding on all bidders and will form part of the bid documents.

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6. MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS

As per the bidding process available in the tender. The bidder cannot modify or withdraw its bid after submission.

7. LANGUAGE OF BID & CORRESPONDENCE

The proposal will be prepared by the Bidder in English language only. All the documents relating to the proposal (including brochures) supplied by the firm should also be in English, and the correspondence between the Bidder & WTL will be in English language only. The correspondence by fax/E-mail must be subsequently confirmed by a duly signed formal copy.

8. BIDDER'S SOLUTION

The bidders are requested to study the Bill of Material supplied with this document carefully. While working out the solution the bidder has to work with the broad minimum specification provided in the tender documents, conforming to the model, make and Part number (wherever provided). While submitting the bid the bidder has to detail out all components needed to complete the system BOM. The bidder is required quote for each item retaining all major components/sub system detailed and specified. As the contractor will be responsible for smooth functioning of the system, availability of spares during the tenure of the warranty period have to be take care by the contractor to maintain the guaranteed uptime.

9. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) / TENDER FEE

The bidder shall furnish Online Receipt against payment of Tender Fees and Earnest Money Deposit

10. REFUND OF EMD

EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders without interest by following guidelines of circular 3975-F(Y) dated 28/07/2016 on final selection of Successful Bidders.

11. FORFEITURE OF EMD

EMD made by Bidder may be forfeited under the following conditions:

If Bidder withdraws the proposal before the expiry of validity period.

During the evaluation process, if a Bidder indulges in any such activity as would jeopardize the process, the decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon question under any circumstances.

If Bidder violates any of the provisions of the terms and conditions of the proposal.

In the case of a successful Bidder, if Bidder fails to:

- a) Accept the work order along with the terms and conditions.
- b) Furnish performance security.
- c) Violates any of the work conditions of this proposal or indulges in any such activities as would jeopardize the work.
- d) Submitting false/misleading information/declaration/documents/proof/etc.

The decision of WTL regarding forfeiture of EMD shall be final and shall not be called upon to question under any circumstances, besides, forfeiture of EMD even the Bidder will be deferred from participating in any job for a period of one year.

12. FORMS AND FORMATS

The various inputs for the Techno Commercial as Financial Bids are to be submitted in the format specified. The bidder shall use the form, wherever specified, to provide relevant information. If form does not provide space for any required information, space at the end of the form or additional sheets

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shall be used to convey the said information. For all other cases, the bidder shall design a form to hold the required information.

13. LACK OF INFORMATION TO BIDDER

The bidder shall be deemed to have carefully examined the Bid document to his entire satisfaction. Any lack of information shall not relieve the bidder of his responsibility to fulfill his obligation under the bid. If bidder has any queries relating to bid document then he can send the queries before the Pre Bid Meeting.

14. CONTRACT EXECUTION

On receipt of the Letter of Award the contractor should submit a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) equivalent to 10% of the total contract value within three weeks from the date of receipt of Letter of Award/Order. The PBG should be valid for six month more than the warranty period. All delivery of the material will have to be completed within 45 days from the date of acceptance of contract and the contractor has to ensure all activities leading to the commissioning of the contract to be completed within 75 days from the date of award. Subsequent to the award of contract, the contractor will have to arrange for the requisite material as per BOM.

15. TIME SCHEDULE FOR DELIVERY

Within 6 (six) weeks from the date of receiving final order from WTL.

16. LIQUIDATED DAMAGE / PENALTY

The job includes the supply and installation of materials mentioned in the tender document. In the event of failure to meet the job completion in stipulated date/time liquidated damage may be imposed on the contractor for sum not less than 0.5% of the contract value for that item/job for each week or part thereof, subject to a ceiling of 10% of the total contract value (excluding all taxes & duties and other charges). In the event of LD exceeds 10% of the order value, WTL reserves the right to terminate the contract and WTL will get the job completed by any other competent party. The difference of cost incurred by WTL will be recovered from the contractor and PBG will be invoked.

17. LIABILITY

In case of a default on bidder's part or other liability, WTL shall be entitled to recover damages from the Contractor. In each such instance, regardless of the basis on which WTL is entitled to claim damages from the Contractor (including fundamental breach, negligence, misrepresentation, or other contract or tort claim), Contractor shall be liable for no more than:

- Payment referred to in the Patents and Copyrights clause.
- Liability for bodily injury (including death) or damage to real property and tangible personal property limited to that cause by the Contractor's negligence.
- As to any other actual damage arising in any situation involving non-performance by Contractor pursuant to or in any way related to the subject of this Agreement, the charge paid by WTL for the individual product or Service that is the subject of the Claim. However, the contractor shall not be liable for
- For any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data.
- For any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the Contractor hereunder.

18. PATENTS & COPYRIGHT

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the Contractor to WTL infringes that party's patent or copyright, the Contractor shall defend WTL against that claim at Contractor's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the Contractor, provided that WTL.

- Promptly notifies Contractor in writing of the claim

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- Allows Contractor to control and co-operate with Contractor in the defense and any related settlement negotiations.

Remedies: If such a claim is made or appears likely to be made, WTL would permit Contractor to enable WTL to continue to use the product, or to modify it, or replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent. If Contractor determines that none of these alternatives is reasonably available, WTL agrees to return the product to Contractor on Contractor's written request. Contractor will then give WTL a credit equal to for a machine. WTL's net book value (provided WTL has followed generally accepted accounting principles for a generally available software product produced by Contractor (Program) the amount paid by WTL or 12 months charges (which ever is lesser) and for materials the amount paid by WTL for the materials. These will be Contractor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement.

19. SUSPENSION OF WORK

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

20. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer, i.e. the Directorate of ICDS under the Department of Women & Child Development and Social Welfare, Government of West Bengal., GoWB

21. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

22. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. The Tender Committee will reject a proposal for award if it detects that the bidder has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contract in question. The Tender Committee will declare a firm ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, if it at any time determines that the firm has engaged in corrupt and fraudulent practices in competing for, or in executing, a contract.

23. BIDDING CLAUSE

All decisions taken by the Tender Committee regarding the processing of this tender and award of contract shall be final and binding on all parties concerned.

The Tender Committee reserves the right:

- To vary, modify, revise, amend or change any of the terms and conditions mentioned above and,
- To reject any or all the Tender/s without assigning any reason whatsoever thereof or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby

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incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

24. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION

In every case in which by virtue of the provision of the workmen's compensation Act 1923 or any other relevant acts and rules, compensation to a workmen employed by the contractor, is payable, then this should be done by the Contractor. If WTL is obliged to make any compensation under the said rules and acts, then the amount shall be recovered without prejudice, from the bills and due of the Contractor. WTL shall not be bound to contest any claim made against the Contractor in respect of workmen's compensation.

25. CONTRACTOR'S EMPLOYEES

The Contractor shall comply with the provision of all labour legislation including the requirement of the payment of Wage Act 1936 and the rules framed there under and modifications thereof in respect of men employed by him in carrying out the contract. The Contractor must ensure that he complies with PF, ESI regulation for all his deployed employees. The Contractor shall see that all authorized Sub Contractors under him similarly complied with the above requirement.

26. SAFETY MEASURES

The Contractor shall in the course of execution of the work take all necessary precaution for the protection of all persons and property. The Contractor shall take adequate measures to protect the work and present accident during the work. In the event of any accident to any person or persons or damage or injury of any description to any person or property due to failure on the part of the contractor in taking proper precautionary measures the contractor shall be responsible for and must make good the loss the damage at his own cost to the satisfaction of the department and employees of the department shall be indemnified from all claims or liabilities arising there from or any expenses incurred on account thereof.

27. EQUIPMENT

All tools & tackles necessary for the work shall have to be procured by the contractor unless other wise specified elsewhere in these tender documents. The equipment used by the contractor for a particular work must be appropriate for the type of work. The contractor shall maintain the equipment used on the work properly so that they are in good working condition. In no case shall the contractor use defective or imperfect equipment in the work. The contractor shall arrange to replace or repair all defective equipment so that the progress of the work is not hampered. No defective equipment should be left at the site of work and the department shall not be responsible for any loss or damage to any of these equipments during the course of the execution of the work.

28. SUB-CONTRACT

The purchaser (WTL) does not recognize the existence of Sub-Contractors. The Contractor's responsibility is not transferable. No consortium partner is allowed.

29. TERMINATION FOR DEFAULT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

30. BANKRUPTCY

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If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

31. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.
- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.
- Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

32. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Appropriate insurance to cover all solution components for the transit period and until the time of its acceptance at the respective site is to be taken by the contractor. As the contractor will carry the risk for the material in his books during transit, the contractor should arrange insurance for the total system as period from the dispatch till Acceptance Test is successfully achieved. Further the contractor is to take all required insurance coverage in respect of all its personnel who shall be working on this engagement.

33. WARRANTY SUPPORT & SLA

As per Section - O

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34. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment as well as performance of on-site warranty support, as mentioned in Bill of Material, from the date of final acceptance of systems and pertaining to proper running of the systems, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the contract value as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – N).

35. SI/BIDDER/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Refer Section – A (Scope of Work & Responsibility)

36. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

37. GRAFTS, COMMISSIONS, GIFTS, ETC.

It is the Purchaser's policy to require that bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants under contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. Any graft, commission, gift or advantage given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the contractor or his partner, agent, officers, director, employee or servant or any one on his or their behalf in relation to the obtaining or to the execution of this or any other contract with WTL shall in addition to any criminal liability which it may incur, subject the contractor to the cancellation of this and all other contracts and also to payment of any loss or damage to WTL resulting from any cancellation. WTL shall then be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any monies otherwise due to the contractor under contract.

38. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

39. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates.

40. TAXES & DUTIES

- The prices shall be inclusive of all taxes & levies including GST and other statutory duties as applicable. Rate of taxes should be indicated separately in the Price Bid.
- Contract Price specified in Price Bid should be based on the taxes & duties and charges prevailing at the date one day prior to the last date of Bid submission.
- Statutory deduction, wherever applicable, shall be made from invoice as per government rules. Necessary certificate will be issued for such deductions.
- Bidder submitting a bid shall produce valid statutory documents / certificates with respect to GST, Income Tax, ROC, Prof. Tax, Trade Licence, etc. All such documents / certificates shall remain valid on the last date of tender submission.

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- In case of inter-state transaction, WTL will provide “Waybill”. However, statutory charges, if any will be borne by the bidder.
- GST component of the invoice of the bidder may be kept on hold in case there is any mismatch / irregularity in GST return filing on the part of the bidder.

41. DISCREPANCIES IN BID

- Discrepancy between description in words and figures, the rate which corresponds to the words quoted by the bidder shall be taken as correct.
- Discrepancy in the amount quoted by the bidder due to calculation mistake of the unit rate then the unit rate shall be regarded as firm.
- Discrepancy in totaling or carry forward in the amount quoted by the bidder shall be corrected.

42. BID DUE DATE

The online tender has to be submitted not later than the due date and time specified in the Important Dates Sheet. WTL may at its discretion on giving reasonable notice by fax, or any other written communication to all prospective bidders who have been issued the bid documents, extend the bid due date, in which case all rights and obligations of the WTL and the bidders, previously subject to the bid due date, shall thereafter be subject to the new bid due date as extended.

43. OPENING OF BID BY WTL

Bids shall be opened and downloaded electronically through operation of the process in the e-Tender portal in presence of Tender Committee. Bidders interested to remain present during electronic bid opening may attend the bid opening session at WTL premises at scheduled date & time.

44. CONTACTING WTL

Bidder shall not approach WTL officers beyond office hours and/or outside WTL office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WTL office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WTL, it should be in writing following the procedure mentioned hereinabove.

45. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

46. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing GST, levies, duties, cess etc.

47. PRICE

- Price should be quoted in the Price Bid format only. No deviation in any form in the Price Bid sheet is acceptable.
- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

48. CANVASSING

Canvassing or support in any form for the acceptance of any tender is strictly prohibited. Any bidder doing so will render him liable to penalties, which may include removal of this name from the register of approved Contractors.

49. NON-TRANSFERABILITY OF TENDER

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This tender document is not transferable.

50. FORMATS AND SIGNING OF BID

The original and all copies of the proposals shall be neatly typed and shall be signed by an authorized signatory(ies) on behalf of the Bidder. The authorization shall be provided by written Power of Attorney accompanying the proposal. All pages of the proposal, except for un-amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the proposal. The proposal shall contain no interlineations, erase or overwriting. In order to correct errors made by the Bidder, all corrections shall be done & initialed with date by the authorized signatory after striking out the original words/figures completely.

51. WITHDRAWAL OF BID

Bid cannot be withdrawn during the interval between their submission and expiry of Bid's validity period. Fresh Bid may be called from eligible bidders for any additional item(s) of work not mentioned herein, if so required.

52. INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS

If any bidder should find discrepancies or omission in the specifications or other tender documents, or if he should be in doubt as to the true meaning of any part thereof, he shall make a written request to the tender inviting authority for correction/clarification or interpretation or can put in a separate sheet along with his technical bid document.

53. SPLITTING OF THE CONTRACT AND CURTAILMENT OF WORK

WTL reserve the right to split up and distribute the work among the successful bidders and to curtail any item of work in the schedule partly or fully.

54. PREPARATION OF TENDER

Tender shall be submitted in accordance with the following instructions:

- a) Tenders shall be submitted in the prescribed forms. Digital signatures shall be used. Where there is conflict between the words and the figures, the words shall govern.
- b) All notations must be in ink or type written. No erasing or overwriting will be permitted. Mistakes may be crossed out and corrections typed or written with ink adjacent thereto and must be initialed in ink by the person or persons signing the tender.
- c) Tenders shall not contain any recapitulation of the work to be done. Alternative proposals will not be considered unless called for. No written, oral, telegraphic or telephonic proposals for modifications will be acceptable.
- d) Tenders shall be uploaded as notified on or before the date and time set for the opening of tenders in the Notice Inviting Tenders.
- e) Tenders subject to any conditions or stipulations imposed by the bidder are liable to be rejected.
- f) Each and every page of the tender document must be signed with company seal by the bidder.
- g) Any bidder may withdraw his tender by written request at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of tenders and not thereafter.

55. PRE-DISPATCH INSTRUCTION

All materials / equipments supplied against the purchase order shall be subjected to Inspection, check and /or test by the authorized representative from WTL.

56. FINAL INSPECTION

Final inspection will be carried by the authorized representative from WTL.

57. SITE INSPECTION

Bidder can inspect (at their own cost) the sites if required, for which they have to take necessary permission from WTL in writing. WTL will take at least four days to organize such permission.

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58. ERASURES OR ALTERNATIONS

The offers with overwriting and erasures may make the tender liable for rejection if each of such overwriting/erasures/manuscript ions is not only signed by the authorized signatory of the bidder. There should be no hand-written material, corrections or alterations in the offer. Technical details must be completely filled up. Correct technical information of the product being offered must be filled in. Filling up of the information using terms such as "OK", "accepted", "noted", "as given in brochure/manual" is not acceptable. The Customer may treat offers not adhering to these guidelines as unacceptable. The Customer may, at its discretion, waive any minor non-conformity or any minor irregularity in the offer. This shall be binding on all bidders and the Tender Committee reserves the right for such waivers.

59. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

The contractor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The contractor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

60. CLARIFICATION OF BIDS

During evaluation of the bids, the Customer/Tender Committee, at its discretion may ask the bidder for clarification of its bid. The request for the clarification and the response shall be in writing (fax/email) and no change in the substance of the bid shall seek offered or permitted.

61. DEEMED ACCEPTANCE

Deliverables will be deemed to be fully and finally accepted by the Directorate of ICDS under the WCD & SW Department, GoWB has not submitted such Deliverable Review Statement to Bidder/Implementation Partner before the expiration of the 30-days review period, or when the WCD & SW Department uses the Deliverable in its business, whichever occurs earlier ("Deemed Acceptance").

62. QUALITY CONTROL
