SCOPE OF WORK & RESPONSIBILITY

Introduction

Backward Classes Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal intent to setup Smart Class room in Government run / aided schools in the SC & ST concentrated areas of the state.

For System Integrator

- 1) Supply: Entrusted bidder must supply and work as per work order. All supplies must be certified, new and RoHS compliant. Supplied components must satisfy the minimum guiding specifications and guidelines, as applicable, proprietary technology must be mentioned against each component. Bidder is allowed to propose only one make / model per system and Digital content required for the proposed solution. Bids with optional offers would be summarily rejected.
- 2) Installation, Integration & Implementation: Delivery & Installation will be governed by the stated guidelines and associated standards & in line with the scope of work defined in this document. The delivery / supply of the materials done by successful Bidder at respective location only. The Post installation warranty supports are the sole responsibility of the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM).
- 3) Service Quality and Assurance: Services within onsite warranty period must be rendered with OEM for hardware.
- 4) Acceptance: After successful Delivery & installation, installation reports prepare by WTL, signed and sealed by authorized officials of BCW Department.
- 5) Warranty: All hardware component service items should have minimum onsite warranty period of period i.e. 36 months from the date of delivery. Within warranty period, entrusted OEM will replace, re-integrate faulty, buggy components. . One dedicated email id has to be created by the bidder/sand to be shared to all schools during delivery to receive complains
- 6) Delivery: All materials will be delivered at the Schools identified by BCW Department within 24-32 weeks from the date of work order. Before delivery of materials successful bidder will complete necessary checking, testing and marking of materials. After necessary checking, testing, marking of the all materials under supervision of WTL, successful bidder will take necessary step to transport the material at installation site and take up the installation there at their own cost. Indicative School names are given in List of Schools (Tentative). The bidder provide school-wise delivery challan and installation certificate duly signed and stamped by school authority and PO/DWOs of the respective district. Beside that after completion of project the bidder has to submit three copies district-wise spiral binded booklet with clear pictures of 2 Nos. of smart classrooms (showing that the materials are delivered, installed and working) and one front elevation of school with of every school with latitude and longitude.
- 7) Warranty Certificate: On successful installation bidder to get installed equipments with actual serial no. with warranty tenure reflected in respective OEM website for three years warranty coverage.
- 8) Training: Bidder should be responsible for providing necessary training to the end users in all schools. Training will be conducted on both online and offline mode. After successful delivery and installation of materials, the bidder has to provide one offline training in each and every district. The bidder has to arrange the venue (one school in the district), communicate to all the schools of the district to attained the training, arrange trainers, providing user manual and other training materials and other necessary arrangements at the training venue. Online training will be scheduled to follow the offline training. Bidder has to schedule the district-wise training, generate the link for training and share them to all the schools and arrange trainings centrally. All the offline and online trainings will be conducted under the supervision of BCWD, WTL and PO/DWOs of the respective district. Beside that the bidders have to shoot a small tutorial video on Digital Content and hardware handling and upload the same on youtube.

- For any indirect, consequential loss or damage, lost profits, third party loss or damage to property or loss of or damage to data.

For any direct loss or damage that exceeds the total payment for Contract Price made or expected to be made to the Contractor hereunder.

18. PATENTS & COPYRIGHT

If a third party claims that a product delivered by the Contractor to WTL infringes that party's patent or copyright, the Contractor shall defend WTL against that claim at Contractor's expense and pay all costs, damages, and attorney's fees that a court finally awards or that are included in a settlement approved by the Contractor, provided that WTL.

- Promptly notifies Contractor in writing of the claim
- Allows Contractor to control and co-operate with Contractor in the defense and any related settlement negotiations.

Remedies: If such a claim is made or appears likely to be made, WTL would permit Contractor to enable WTL to continue to use the product, or to modify it, or replace it with one that is at least functionally equivalent. 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accounting principles for a generally available software product produced by Contractor (Program) the amount paid by WTL or 12 months charges (which ever is lesser) and for materials the amount paid by WTL for the materials. These will be Contractor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement.

19. SUSPENSION OF WORK

WTL shall have the power at any time and from time to time by notice to the Contractor to delay or suspend the progress of the work or any part of the work due to any other adequate reasons and on receipt of such notice the contractor shall forthwith suspend further progress of the work until further notice from WTL. The Contractor shall recommence work immediately after receiving a notice to do so from WTL. The whole or any part of the time lost for such delay or suspension shall, if WTL in its absolute discretion thinks fit, but not otherwise, be added to the time allowed for completion.

20. TERMS OF PAYMENT

Payment terms will be on back-to-back basis, i.e., payment will be made only on receipt of payment from relevant customer, i.e., West Bengal Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes Development & Finance Corporation (A Government of West Bengal Undertaking) . Payment will be release after successful delivery and installation.

21. GOVERNING LAWS

This contract should be governed by and interpreted by Arbitration clause in accordance with Laws in force in India. The courts at Kolkata shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters arising under the contract. The selected vendor shall keep himself fully informed of all current national, state and municipal law and ordinances. The selected vendor shall at their own expense, obtain all necessary permits and license and pay all fees and taxes required by law. These will be selected vendor's entire obligation regarding any claim of infringement. The selected vendor hereto agrees that it shall comply with all applicable union, state and local laws, ordinances, regulations and codes in performing its obligations hereunder, including the procurement of licenses, permits certificates and payment of taxes where required. The selected vendor shall establish and maintain all proper records (particularly, but without limitation, accounting records) required by any law, code/practice of corporate policy applicable to it from time to time including records and returns as applicable under labor legislation.

22. CORRUPT OR FRAUDULENT

The Tender Committee requires that the bidders under this Tender observe the highest standards of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. For this purpose the definition of corrupt and fraudulent practices will follow the provisions of the relevant laws in force. 27. EQUIPMENT

WTL may without prejudice to any other remedy or right of claim for breach of contract by giving not less than 30 days written notice of default sent to the contractor, terminate the order in whole or in part. If the contractor materially fails to render any or all the services within the time period specified in the contract or any extension thereof granted by WTL in writing and fails to remedy its failure within a period of thirty days after receipt of default notice from WTL. If the project (delivery, commissioning as well as warranty maintenance support is not carried out according to specification due to deficiency in service as per terms of the contract. In such case WTL will invoke the amount held back from the contractor as PBG.

30. BANKRUPTCY

If the contractor becomes bankrupt or have a receiving order made against him or compound with his creditors or being a corporation commence to be wound up, not being a voluntary winding up for the purpose only or amalgamation or reconstruction, or carry on their business under a receiver for the benefit of their creditors or any of them, WTL shall be at liberty to terminate the engagement forthwith without any notice in writing to the contractor or to the liquidator or receiver or to any person in whom the contractor may become vested and without any compensation to give such liquidator or receiver or other person the option of carrying out the engagement subject to their providing a guarantee for the due and faithful performance of the engagement up to an amount to be determined by WTL.

31. FORCE MAJEURE

It is hereby defined as any cause, which is beyond the control of the Contractor or WTL as the case may be, which such party could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as

- War, Hostilities or warlike operations (whether a state of war be declared or not), invasion, act of foreign enemy and civil war.
- Rebellion, revolution, insurrection, mutiny, usurpation of civil or military, government, conspiracy, riot, civil commotion and terrorist area.
- Confiscation, nationalization, mobilization, commandeering or requisition by or under the order

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of any government or de facto authority or ruler, or any other act or failure to act of any local state or national government authority.

- Strike, sabotage, lockout, embargo, import restriction, port congestion, lack of usual means of public transportation and communication, industrial dispute, shipwreck, shortage of power supply epidemics, quarantine and plague.
- Earthquake, landslide, volcanic activity, fire flood or inundation, tidal wave, typhoon or cyclone, hurricane, nuclear and pressure waves or other natural or physical disaster.

If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances of the event of Force Majeure within fourteen days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed.

The party or parties affected by the event of Force Majeure shall use reasonable efforts to mitigate the effect of the event of Force Majeure upto its or their performance of the Contract and to fulfill its or their obligation under the Contract but without prejudice to either party's right to terminate the Contract.

No delay or nonperformance by either party to this Contract caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Majeure shall.

- Constitute a default or breach of the contract.
- Give rise to any claim from damages or additional cost or expense occurred by the delay or nonperformance. If, and to the extent, that such delay or nonperformance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.

32. INSURANCE COVERAGE

Appropriate insurance to cover all solution components for the transit period and until the time of its acceptance at the respective site is to be taken by the contractor. As the contractor will carry the risk for the material in his books during transit, the contractor should arrange insurance for the total system as period from the dispatch till Acceptance Test is successfully achieved. Further the contractor is to take all required insurance coverage in respect of all its personnel who shall be working on this engagement.

33. WARRANTY

The OEM on behalf of bidder will warranty that product supplied under the contract are newly made and are free from defects in the design, engineering and workmanship. The Contractor would be responsible for the up keep and maintenance of the LED INTERACTIVE TOUCH PANEL , OPS , Line Interactive UPS Visualiser Camera (FHD) etc. under the scope of work during the entire warranty period, i.e. 36 months from the date of delivery. Within warranty period, respective OEM will replace, re-integrate faulty, buggy components. The Contractor/OEM shall not, without the express prior written consent of WTL, assign to any third party of the contract or part thereof. Service support for the entire warranty period will be on site and comprehensive (including spares) and free of cost for the entire warranty period. Warranty will be invalid if the equipment is serviced by unauthorized personnel of misuse is detected.

34. WARRANTY SUPPORT

As per Warranty clause.

35. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE (PBG)

As a guarantee for timely delivery, installation and commissioning of equipment as well as performance of on-site warranty support, as mentioned in Bill of Material, from the date of final acceptance of systems and pertaining to proper running of the systems, the bidder will have to submit 10% of the net contract value as security in the form of Performance Bank Guarantee from any nationalized bank as per format enclosed (Section – P).

36. SI/BIDDER/CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES

Refer Section – A (Scope of Work & Responsibility)

37. NO WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Neither the inspection by WTL or any of their agents nor any order by WTL for payment of money or any

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payment for or acceptance of the whole or any part of the works by WTL, nor any extension of time, nor any possession taken by WTL shall operate as a waiver of any provision of the contract or of any power reserved to WTL, or any right to damages here in provided, nor shall any waiver of any breach in the contract be held to be a waiver of any other subsequent breach.

38. GRAFTS, COMMISSIONS, GIFTS, ETC.

It is the Purchaser's policy to require that bidders, suppliers, contractors and consultants under contracts, observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement and execution of such contracts. Any graft, commission, gift or advantage given, promised or offered by or on behalf of the contractor or his partner, agent, officers, director, employee or servant or any one on his or their behalf in relation to the obtaining or to the execution of this or any other contract with WTL shall in addition to any criminal liability which it may incur, subject the contractor to the cancellation of this and all other contracts and also to payment of any loss or damage to WTL resulting from any cancellation. WTL shall then be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from any monies otherwise due to the contractor under contract.

39. ENFORCEMENT OF TERMS

The failure of either party to enforce at any time any of the provision of this contract or any rights in respect thereto or to exercise any option here in provided shall in no way be construed to be a waiver to such provisions, rights or options or in any way to affect the validity of the contract. The exercise by either party of any of its rights herein shall not preclude or prejudice either party from exercising the same or any other right it may have hereunder.

40. PERIOD OF VALIDITY OF OFFER

For the purpose of placing the order, the proposals shall remain valid till 180 days. During the period of validity of proposals, the rates quoted shall not change. In exceptional circumstances, WTL may ask for extension of the period of validity and such a request shall be binding on Bidders. WTL's request and the response to such a request by various Bidders shall be in writing. A Bidder agreeing to such an extension will not be permitted to increase its rates.

41. TAXES & DUTIES

46. CONTACTING WTL

Bidder shall not approach WTL officers beyond office hours and/or outside WTL office premises from the time of the Bid opening to the time of finalization of successful bidder. Any effort by bidder to influence WTL office in the decision on Bid evaluation, Bid comparison or finalization may result in rejection of the Bidder's offer. If the bidder wishes to bring additional information to the notice of WTL, it should be in writing following the procedure mentioned hereinabove.

47. WTL'S RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

WTL reserves the right to reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder(s) or any obligation to inform the affected bidder(s) of the grounds for such decision.

48. BID CURRENCIES

Prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees, inclusive of all prevailing GST, levies, duties, cess etc.

49. PRICE

- Price should be quoted in the Price Bid format only. No deviation in any form in the Price Bid sheet is acceptable.
- Price quoted should be firm, inclusive of packing, forwarding, insurance and freight charges.
- Percentage/specified amount of taxes & duties should be clearly mentioned otherwise WTL reserves the right to reject such vague offer.
- Price to be quoted inclusive of supply, installation & commissioning charges.

50. CANVASSING

60. ERASURES OR ALTERNATIONS

The offers with overwriting and erasures may make the tender liable for rejection if each of such overwriting/erasures/manuscript ions is not only signed by the authorized signatory of the bidder. There should be no hand-written material, corrections or alterations in the offer. Technical details must be completely filled up. Correct technical information of the product being offered must be filled in. Filling up of the information using terms such as "OK", "accepted", "noted", "as given in brochure/manual" is not acceptable. - **Step 2 – Financial Proposal**

The financial bids of shortlisted bidder's scoring at least 70% marks in the technical proposal (Step-1) (Bidders those score minimum 70% marks in the technical proposal will be considered for financial proposal opening.

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- **Technical Score:** The total score obtained by the bidder as per the technical proposal shall be the technical score (Ts) of the bidders.

NOW THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSTH AS UNDER

In consideration of the above premises and agreements all the Members in this Consortium agreement do hereby mutually agree as follows: ·

1. We, the Members of the Consortium and Members to the Agreement do hereby unequivocally agree that _____ shall act as the Lead Member for the Consortium.
2. The Lead Member shall be liable and responsible for ensuring the individual and collective commitment of each of the Members of the Consortium in discharging all of their respective obligations. Each Member further undertakes to be individually liable for the performance of its part of the obligations envisaged in this Agreement.
3. Subject to the terms of this Agreement, the Consortium Partner shall be responsible for providing technical knowledge required for the Tender to the Lead Member. Furthermore, Lead member and Consortium Partner shall enter into a separate definitive agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Definitive Agreement") with each other defining respective rights, duties, obligations, liabilities, etc. of both the parties for the performance of the obligations as per the Tender.

4. This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the Laws of India and courts at Kolkata alone shall have the exclusive jurisdiction in all matters relating thereto and arising there under.

5. It is hereby further agreed that in case of being shortlisted, the Members do hereby agree that they shall abide by the terms & conditions of the Tender.

6. It is further expressly agreed that this Agreement shall be irrevocable and shall form an integral part of the bid submitted to WTL and shall remain in full force and effect until the date of occurrence of any of the following events or conditions. whichever shall first occur: -

- a) Termination of the Tender;
- b) Rejection of Bid submitted by the Parties in consortium with each other;
- c) Contract/Bid is awarded to a third party;
- d) The Lead Member decides not to submit the Bid.

6. 1 Consequences of Termination/ expiry

(a) Each Party shall handover all information, documents, materials, Confidential Information of the other Party as may be provided by such other Party in accordance with the terms of this Consortium Agreement within 15 (fifteen) days of termination of this Consortium Agreement.

(b) The Consortium Partner shall maintain all data, all necessary and required records, registers and accounts in respect of the services provided and shall furnish the same to Lead Partner on request.

7. In case the Consortium is declared as successful bidder and Contract is awarded to the Consortium, then Lead Member and Consortium Partner shall enter into Definitive Agreement defining respective rights, duties, obligations, liabilities etc. of both the parties for the performance of the obligations as per Tender. Further, the Consortium Members shall continue to be members of the Consortium and continue to fulfil their respective obligations/scope of work under this Consortium Agreement post award of the Bid/Contract, for the duration specified in the Tender.

8. It is hereby expressly understood between the Members that no Member at any given point of time, may assign or delegate its rights, duties or obligations under this agreement without the explicit permission of WTL.

9. Each Party to this Consortium Agreement shall bear its respective costs, expenses and liabilities as a result of its obligations and efforts under this Agreement. Neither Party shall have any right to any reimbursement, payment or compensation of any kind from each other during the period prior to the award of the contract by WTL nor, any other contract executed in consequence of this Consortium Agreement. However, it is clarified that this clause shall not apply over the Definitive Agreement entered into between both the parties as per this agreement.

10. This Agreement: ^[11]_{SEP} a) has been duly executed and delivered on behalf of each Member hereto and constitutes the legal, valid, binding and enforceable obligation of each such Member; b) sets forth the entire understanding of the Members hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof: and ^[12]_{SEP} c) May not be amended or modified except in writing signed by each of the Members and with prior written consent of WTL.

11. If at any time any dispute, differences or question arises between the Parties concerning the meaning, construction, interpretation, effect and scope of this Consortium Agreement regarding the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties under this Consortium Agreement, then such disputes, differences or question shall be amicably resolved through mutual discussions

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and negotiations ; if the Parties fail to resolve such dispute within 30 days of commencement of amicable settlement process such dispute shall be referred to and finally resolved by arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (as amended from time to time). The Arbitration procedure shall be conducted in English language at Kolkata. The arbitration award passed by the sole arbitrator (mutually appointed by the parties) shall be final and binding on the Parties.

12 Legal Relationship

12.1 Relationship between the Parties is on principal to principal basis. This Consortium Agreement does not in any respect make Consortium Partner an agent or a partner of the Lead Member nor does it establish any joint venture between the Parties or authorize the Consortium Partner to transact any business in the name of the Lead Member or to incur any obligation or liability for or on behalf of the Lead Member except as otherwise specifically set forth herein or as may be agreed upon specifically in writing.

12.2 Each Party confirms it is acting on its own behalf and not for the benefit of any other Party.

13. Indemnity

Each Party (the Indemnifying Party") shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the other Party (the Indemnified Party") from any and all direct costs, losses, liabilities or expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred by the Indemnified Party to the extent arising from the breach by the Indemnifying Party of any of its obligations under this Consortium Agreement.

Each Party acknowledges that monetary damages would not be a sufficient remedy for any breach of this Consortium Agreement by such Party and that the other Party would suffer irreparable harm as a result of any such breach. Accordingly, each Party will be entitled to equitable remedies, including but not limited to injunctive relief and specific performance for any breach or threatened breach of this Consortium Agreement by the other Party, in addition to any other rights or remedies available to such Party.

14. Limitation of Liability

No Party shall be liable towards the other Party for consequential, indirect, incidental, or special (including multiple or punitive) damages of any kind, including, but not limited to, lost orders, sales or profits.

15. Assignment

Neither party shall have the right to assign or otherwise transfer, in whole or in part, any of its rights or obligations under this Consortium Agreement without obtaining prior written consent from the other party.

16. Severable Terms

The provisions of this Consortium Agreement are severable. If any provision is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be in valid, void or unenforceable under the existing law, that provision shall be modified to the extent necessary to make it enforceable. The remaining provisions of this Consortium Agreement or validity of this Consortium Agreement shall not be affected or impaired thereby.

17. Waiver and Amendment

No provision of this Consortium Agreement shall be modified or waived, except by a writing signed by an authorized person from each party in presence of two witnesses .Any failure or delay in asserting any provision or breach does not waive that or WTL/BCWD/HW/25-26/057 dated 25.02.2026

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any other provision or breach. A waiver does not act as a waiver of any provision or breach on any other occasion.

Entire Agreement

This Consortium Agreement sets forth the entire understanding and agreement of the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all other oral or written representations, arrangements and understanding.
